



Washing & Care Instructions

Copper Collection

Due to the handwoven nature of our copper creations and their intended uses, the colour of the copper will change over time. The copper oxidises due to moisture in the air and exposure to oxygen and this is an entirely natural process.

To make your copper homewares sparkling and new again, please:

- Create a mixture of 3 cups of water, 1 cup of white vinegar and a tablespoon of salt
- Bring mixture to the boil, immerse your copper in the water & allow to simmer for a few minutes
- Wipe the copper clean with a dry cloth and then set out in the sunshine to dry completely

Other important points about copper homewares care:

- Exposure to moisture can cause the copper to oxidise faster so limit exposure with liquid
- To wash, simply wipe clean with warm water and white vinegar and then set aside to dry
- The copper is durable so can withstand pressure, weight and falls, simply bend back into shape
- When serving food on copper wipe clean with warm water & white vinegar before and after use



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
